**Q1** How likely are you to vote in next November's election for Congress and other important offices? Will you definitely vote, probably vote, are the chances 50/50, or will you probably not vote?

<i>Will definitely vote</i> .....	95%
<i>Will probably vote</i> .....	5%
<i>Chances are 50/50</i> .....	0%

**Q2** Do you approve or disapprove of the job Representative Frank LoBiondo is doing in Congress?

<i>Approve</i> .....	39%

**Q3** If the election for Congress were today, would you vote to re-elect Republican Frank LoBiondo, or would you vote for his Democratic opponent?

**Q5** Leaders in Congress from both parties are considering immigration reform legislation that would strengthen border security, block employers from hiring undocumented immigrants, and require that undocumented immigrants already in the U.S. without a criminal record register for legal status, learn English, pay taxes, and be allowed to work towards citizenship over time. Now that the government has reopened, would you support or oppose Congress passing immigration reform legislation?

**Q9** If you are Hispanic, press 1. If white, press 2. If African-American, press 3. If other, press 4.

<i>Hispanic</i> .....	7%
<i>White</i> .....	81%
<i>African-American</i> .....	7%
<i>Other</i> .....	5%

**Q10** If you are 18 to 29 years old, press 1. If 30 to 45, press 2. If 46 to 65, press 3. If you are older than 65, press 4.

<i>18 to 29</i> .....	9%
<i>30 to 45</i> .....	27%
<i>46 to 65</i> .....	42%
<i>Older than 65</i> .....	22%
